Important Winter Reminders

✦ There is **NO PARKING** on any Village street from 3:00 am to 6:00 am from November 1 through April 1. Parking Tickets Will Be Issued!

✦ It is against Village ordinance to put any snow or ice removed from your property on any Village street, alley or sidewalk.

✦ It is important to make sure that all exits from your home or business are clear of snow and ice. If a fire, or something else, is blocking one exit you will need to be able to open the door and get out another exit. It is easy to overlook but pretty critical in an emergency.

✦ Please take a minute to make sure that all exhaust pipes from your home are clear of snow and ice.

✦ Home and Business owners are responsible to keep the sidewalk in front of their property clear. The Village is responsible for initial snow removal on Village sidewalks, when the streets are plowed by Public Works. Any additional snow or ice removal is the owner/residents responsibility.



Tax Payments and New Payment Option

Real Estate Taxes for 2022 will be due in 2023. The first installment or full payment is due January 31st to the Village Treasurer. The second installment is due July 31st to the **County** Treasurer. Personal Property Taxes are due in full by January 31st to the Village Treasurer. If you have any questions regarding your tax payment please contact the Village Office.



DON'T FORGET! All dogs, five (5) months of age and older, must be licensed in the Village each year. Fees for 2023 are: Males/Females \$10 or Neutered Males/Spayed Females \$5. Owner must show proof of rabies vaccination.
